## Match Format

**Match Dates:** **Saturday, April 23, 2016, May 28, 2016 & July 23, 2016** - **60** shot match starting at 9:00 AM.  
60 rounds for score + sighters (recommend a 100 rds total).

**Open Range Day:** We are holding an “Open Range Practice Day” on **Saturday March 26, 2016**. The Club will be Open all day to visitors, friends of members or anyone wanting to check our Club & observe the various shooting disciplines available @ our club. “Hands On” with club members & offering new Family memberships. No amenities are available @ the range, bring your own water & food.

**Location:** HOTSA Gun Club

**Director:** David Brady

**Open to:** Anyone who wants a challenging yet fun shoot on the newest version long range Varmint Benchrest Match anywhere around this area! Our club is the only club around offering the new VBRS type of Match, which includes the added dimension of the 2 additional targets @ 600 & 750 yards!

**Entries:** No limit on entries as we should be to handle up to 40+ shooters.

**Entry Fees:** \$35 for Adults and \$10 for Juniors. Tipping the target setters is optional but encouraged (it's a whole bunch better than setting our own).

**Squadding:** In Silhouette shooting, indicate your spotter & squadding preferences when you check in at the match.

**Rules:** Will be explained at the match but each shooter must have someone confirming their hits/misses and marking their scorecard while they are firing.

**Awards:** **Not finalized as of this writing.**

**Position:** Will be shot from the Benchrest position. We encourage you to bring your own Benches; HOTSA only has a few Club Benches available. Prone position Shooters will probably be partially obstructed @ the 600 & 750 yard Berms, discuss with the Range Officer.

**Equipment:** **Bring your own equipment.** You will need a shooting mat if you plan to shoot prone or a portable shooting bench if you are going to shoot from the bench. Front rest, rear bag rest, spotting scope and tripod, minimum of 60 rounds + Sighters, **No Magnums, .22 Centerfire or calibers above .30 caliber will be allowed on the Range for the match!**

**Match:** Consists of 10 shots for score: Prairie Dog @ 200 meters, Armadillo @ 300 meters, Coyote @ 385 meters meters, Hog @ 500 meters, Prairie Chicken @ 600 yds, & Pig @ 750 yds for a total of 60 rounds for score; **8.5 minutes for 10 rds for Score** (including “**Sighters**”). Note the 1<sup>st</sup> 4 Targets are @ **1 MOA** scale & the last 2 Targets are @ **2 MOA** Scale on the “Swingers”. The match employs usage of the “Silhouette Rules” which means that you can use a “Spotter” to assist in coaching/consulting the shooter & “Sighters” prior to Record shots. We have added a new dimension to this match with the addition of the 2 additional Berms @ our Range with the: **Chicken (2 MOA target @ 600 yds)** and the **Pig (2 MOA target @ 750 yds)**! I am confident that this will be very challenging & a lot of fun. Shooting beyond 500+ yards does offer new & exciting challenges that will cause you to be a better shooter & hunter.
